Primary Wholesale Charges 2018/19 – Statement of Significant Changes

The Wholesale Charging Rules, published by the Water Services Regulation Authority (WSRA), under sections 66E and 117I of the Water Industry Act 1991, require that if Affinity Water intends to make any significant changes to its primary Wholesale Charges, it should publish information that, at a minimum, informs stakeholders of the scope of its proposed changes. For these purposes, changes will be 'significant' if a reasonable person would consider them to be material.

- Taking into account the best information available at this time, Affinity Water does not expect to make any significant changes to its primary Wholesale Charges effective from 1st April 2018.
- Affinity Water considers it unlikely that there will be instances where Wholesale bill
 increases for licensees (as a whole or in groups) who are retailing wholesale services to
 eligible customers, and on customers occupying Eligible Premises (as a whole or in
 groups) will exceed 5%.
- It expects to publish indicative Wholesale Charges by 14th October 2017.
