## Our approach

- our leaders promote occupational health and safety best practice, set a personal example and recognise contributions to achieving zero harm
- we ensure that hazards are risk assessed and controlled to prevent harm
- we define and implement our standards, and comply with applicable legislation
- we ensure that our colleagues and our suppliers are trained and competent to undertake activities safely
- we consult, listen and respond openly to our colleagues, safety representatives, customers and other stakeholders
- if incidents occur, we investigate them to understand the causes and take appropriate action to prevent similar incidents from happening again.

## Our role

We expect everyone who works for or with us to:

- care for themselves and anyone who comes into contact with our activity
- discuss how we will improve safety, health and wellbeing
- familiarise themselves with the safety management system
- follow relevant standards, procedures and safe systems of work
- own issues and ensure they are resolved
- challenge behaviours and conditions that may cause harm, and act on challenges from others
- report all hazards, near misses and incidents
- share learning and prevent similar incidents from occurring in the future.
